<u>CUPA SCHOLARSHIPS – 2018</u>

- The California CUPA Forum (CCF) is pleased to offer up to six scholarship awards to full time California college students.
- Students interested in competing for one of the scholarship awards must present a research project as a power point presentation, or poster board summary, or technical paper and video presentation on a subject related to the environmental/hazardous materials field. Examples of subjects include: remediation for underground tanks, contamination of groundwater, site mitigation, environmental chemistry or toxicology, Nano-technology, Green Chemistry, green technology, pharmaceutical related issues, alternative fuels, pollution prevention, hazwaste treatment options, fracking, new and emerging technology, hazmat incident cause investigations, and emergency preparedness.  - A "CUPA Scholarship Project <u>Application</u>" (see below) outlining the project must be submitted by December 31, 2017 <u>for priority consideration</u>.
 - Winners will be selected by the Student Scholarship Committee(SSC) and presented with the scholarship awards during the CUPA Conference luncheon on Wednesday February 7, 2018.
 - All winners and participants in the research project will be asked to submit their project <u>and</u> a brief video addressing several questions posed by the SSC, for presentation on February 7, 2018, no later than 7:30 am on Student Day.
 - All applicants for the CUPA scholarship competition will be asked to attend the Wednesday Student Day (please complete Form CCSD-2). Participants may receive reimbursement for supplies required to present their projects upon application approval up to \$50. Receipts are required.
 - Voting will take place from 8:00 am 11:00 am on Student Day. Awards will be given in the amounts of \$1,500 for 1st place, 2nd place \$1,000 (2) for 2nd place, \$500(3) for 3rd place.
 - Email a completed application to <u>michele@calcupa.org</u> no later than December 31, 2017, for priority consideration, with later submittals subject to approval at the Board's discretion. Power point presentations to be sent to <u>michele@calcupa.org</u> no later than January 26, 2018.
- **Qualifications**: Must be a full time California college/university student and not working full time in an environmental field. Please provide a copy of your current student ID, front and back. Please note that if you have won a scholarship previously, you will not qualify for this year.

• Student Scholarship Steering Committee Criteria for acceptance:

- Applicability, ingenuity, uniqueness of topic.
- Was the nature of the topic clearly explained.
- Application correctly completed and submitted on time.
- Presentation, problems, statements, methodology, results, lessons learned and conclusions.
- New & emerging issues; alignment with HazMat.
- Relevant to attendees, do the topics match any of our sessions or current hot topics in the world of hazardous materials.
