Players will be able to test their skill at 18 holes of golf in a 4 - person team shotgun format with trophies, longest drive and closest to the pin competitions.

for the golfer that can drive their

marshmallow the farthest.

TOURNAMENT RULES

Everyone tees off

Teams then select the best ball

Teams must use at least 3 tee drives from each player

All players then hit the next shot within a club length from the previous best ball spot nearer to the hole

Continue this until your team reaches the green

Select the best ball on the green and putt within 6 inches of the spot of the best ball

Hole 10 is the longest drive competition hole – 1 for women and 1 for men (ball must be in fairway to count)

Hole 17 is the closest to the pin hole (ball must be on green to count)

Since handicaps are not being used, there will be a blind birdie/bogey draw

6 holes will be chosen at random. Your score will be deducted 1 stroke from your posted score (Birdie) on three randomly chosen holes. For the other three randomly drawn holes, your score will have a stroke added (Bogey). Scores will then be calculated from the adjustments to determine final score.
