

AirTrain

SFO's AirTrain provides year-round service 24 hours a day, with station departures as frequent as every four minutes. AirTrain is wheelchair accessible. Elevator service is available at all AirTrain stations.

AirTrain stations are located in all terminals:

- The Red Line & Blue Lines connects to all terminals. Both lines serve the Grand Hyatt at SFO station. We suggest taking the Red Line train for less travel distance and time to the hotel.
- There are signs located throughout the airport directing you to the AirTrain.
- From Terminal 1, 2 or 3, take the elevator or escalator to Mezzanine Level 3 and walk across the passenger skybridge.
- From inside the International Terminal, access the AirTrain stations near Gates A and G. You can reach the stations by taking the elevator or escalator to Level 4.

There are information booths, staffed with friendly volunteers that are located throughout the terminals.

BART

The directions from BART to the Grand Hyatt are:

- 1. Get off at the SFO BART Station
- 2. Go to the AirTrain Platform on the upper level
- 3. Take the AirTrain's Red Line to the Grand Hyatt at SFO (it will be the 7th station)"
