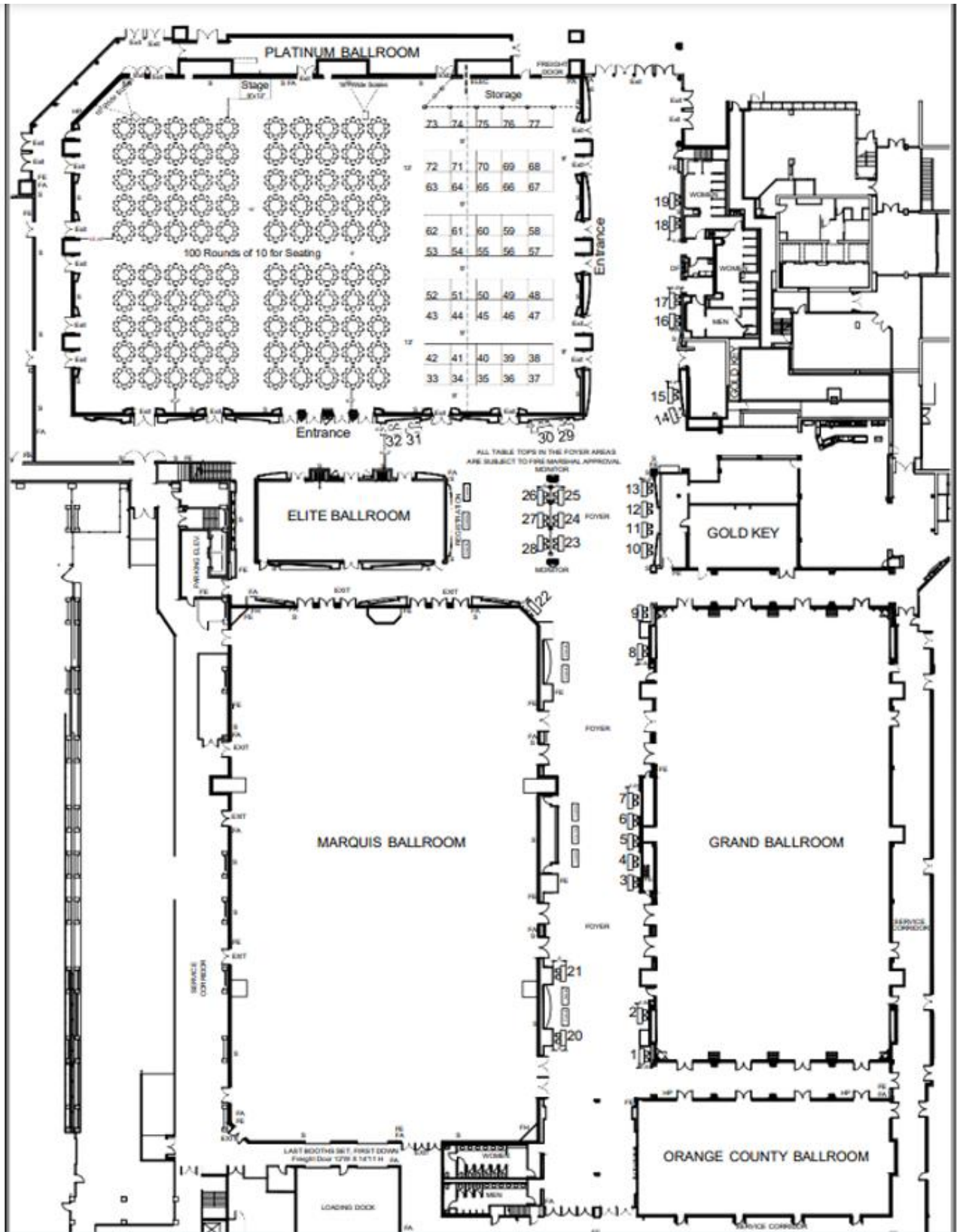

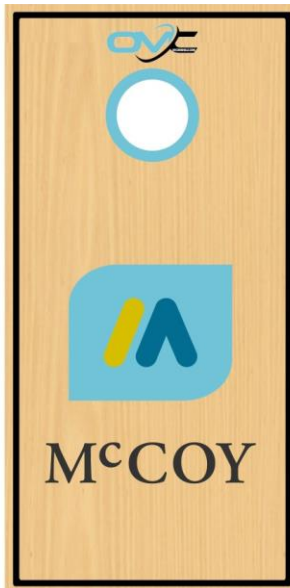

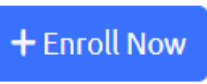

CalCUPA's New Learning Management System (LMS) - On the homepage of the calcupa.org website, you can get access to MANY current Haz Mat Programs training videos from the 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 past annual conferences.
