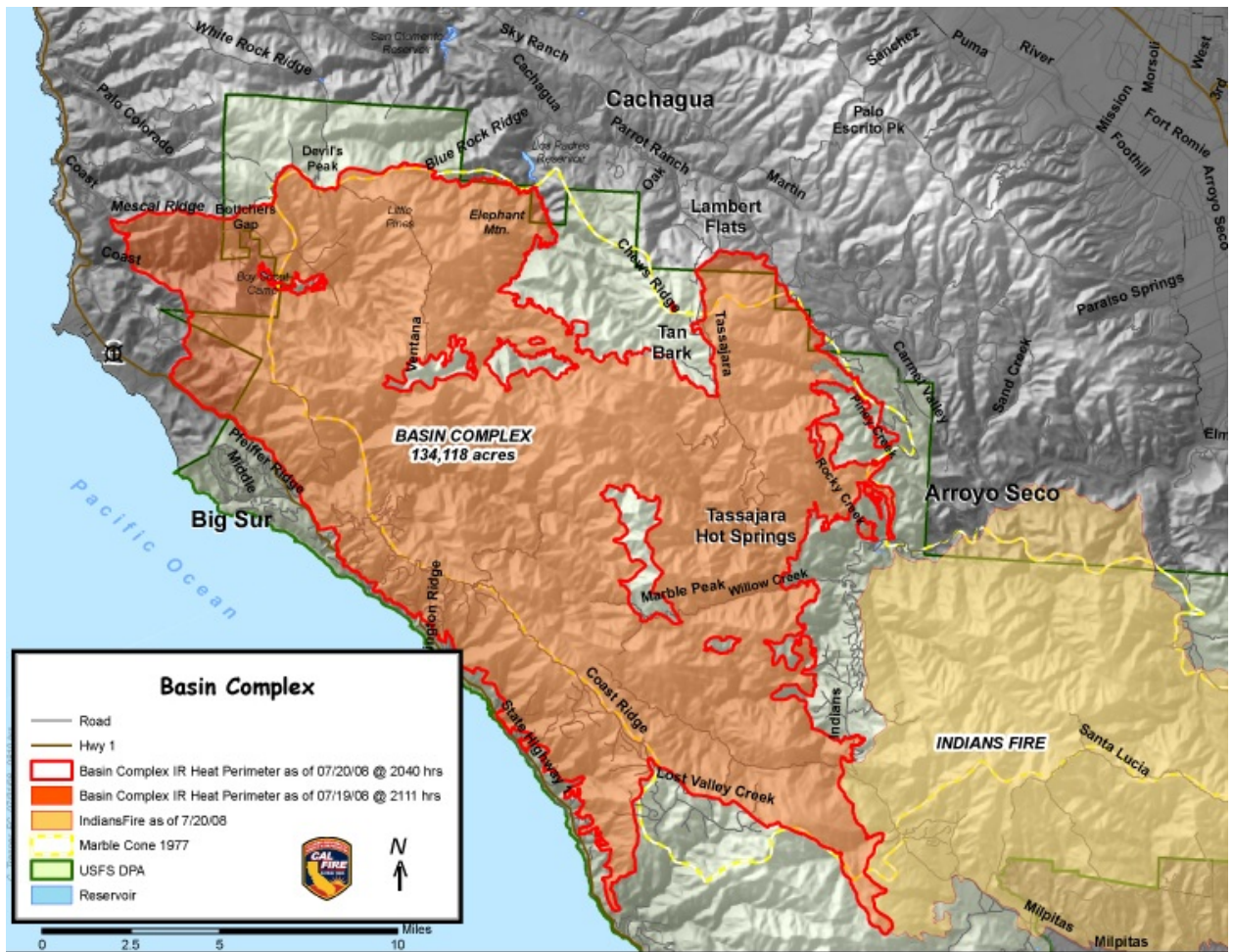

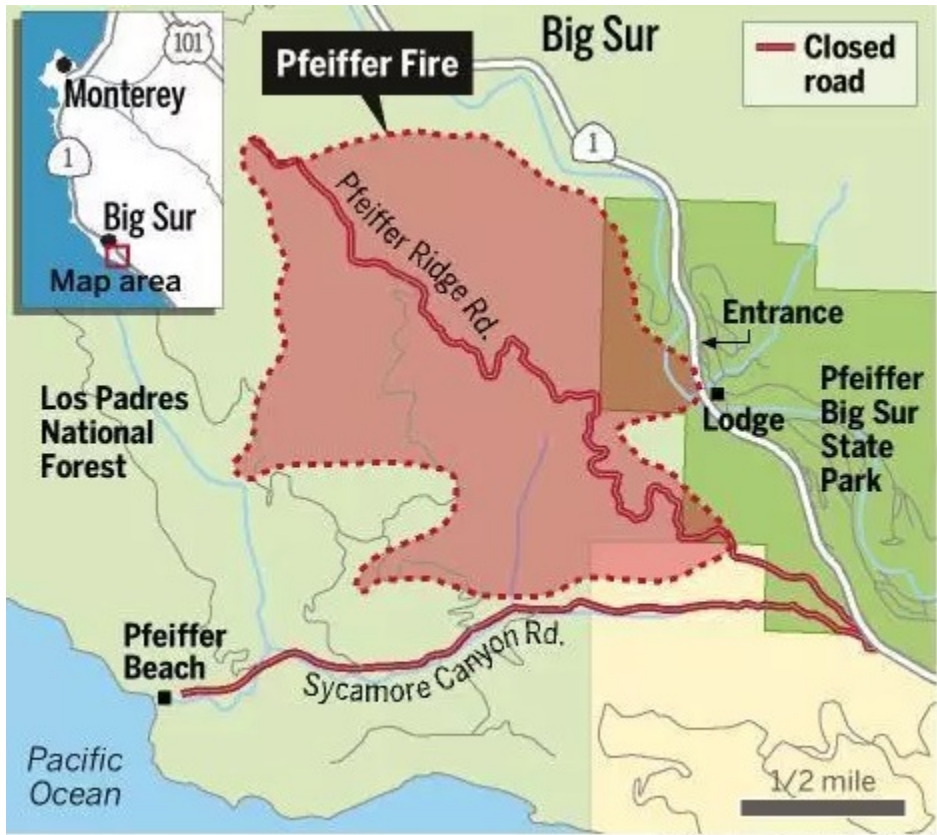

Low density residential community along the coastal hills in Big Sur. Fire was started by electrical control wires from a community water system. Accumulated dry leaves and redwood needles were initial fuel source for fire.
