DESCRIPTION:

The City of Long Beach, Department of Health and Human Services is recruiting for two Environmental Health Specialist (Non-Career) positions in the Environmental Health Bureau. Reporting to an Environmental Health Specialist IV, these positions will perform environmental health inspections for the Consumer Protection Program. Non-Career employees are allowed a maximum of 1,600 work hours available over a 12-month period, and are considered temporary, at-will employees who are not typically eligible for benefits. However, Non-Career employees may qualify for health coverage and sick leave accruals subject to applicable federal and state provisions. These positions will be located at the Main Health Department, 2525 Grand Avenue, Long Beach, CA 90815.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Performs environmental health inspections within one of the Consumer Protection Program Districts;
- Inspects establishments and special events engaged in the manufacturing, processing, handling, or dispensing of food;
- · Investigates citizen complaints regarding community sanitation and food-borne illnesses;
- · Collects samples of food, water, beverages, and other materials for laboratory analysis;
- · Performs pool/spa safety inspections;
- Performs tobacco retail safety and enforcement inspections and sweeps;
- Performs Cottage Food licensing/inspections;
- Performs and/or assists in regular and special inspections of establishments, institutions, dwellings, and facilities subject to the California Retail Food Code (CalCode);
- Inspects dwellings, institutions, and other establishments subject to public health licensing;
- Performs plan checks and inspections of cannabis-related businesses;
- Issues and posts notices of violation;
- Inspects food facilities for proper disposal of fats, oils, and greases;
- Prepares reports detailing noted deficiencies and enforcement actions taken;
- Inspects food street vendors and mobile food operations;
- Performs educational outreach to commercial food workers and members of the public on food protection and safe food handling; and,
- Performs other related duties as required.
