**Minimum Qualifications**

Either: 1. Graduation from an accredited college or university with a major in health science, public health, natural science, physical science, environmental science, or a related field.

-and- Two years of supervisory experience at a level equivalent to the Environmental Specialist IV class within Sacramento County service.

Or: 2. Possession of split off rights as granted by the Civil Service Commission and Board of Supervisors via SRA #90-85. Note: Possession of a Master's Degree from an accredited college or university in health

science, public health, natural science, business or public administration, physical science, environmental science, or a related field may substitute for one year of the required experience.

California certification as a Registered Environmental Health Specialist and a valid California Driver License are required.
