CalOES evaluates three programs:

The CalARP program,

- Hazardous Materials Business Plan Program,
- The Area Plan (s).



Under the HMBP program, Cal OES evaluates:

- Inventories Annual submittals
- Emergency Response and Training Plans Annual submittals
- Inspections -Tri-annual



When CalOES reviews these programs in CERS, we only have what is entered into the CERS program by the handler and the CUPA.

<u>So:</u>

- Be sure everything is in, and everything is complete and correct.
- We will query information and produce a spreadsheet with information from CERS.
- > This includes all your under-threshold HMBP sites, remote sites, sites with all these exemptions we will cover today.

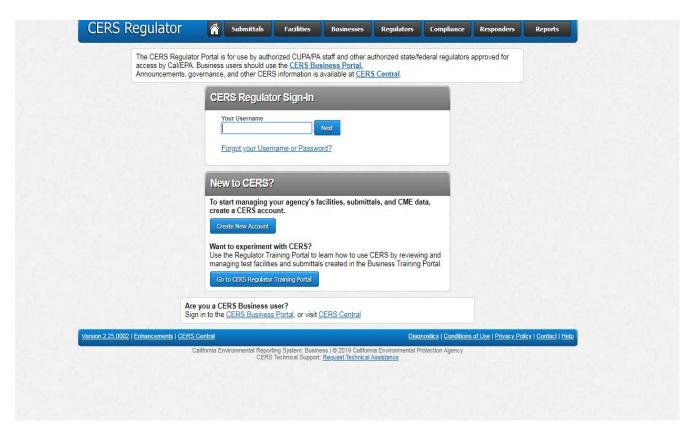


These exemptions, if incorrectly documented, can cause havoc during an evaluation, if they are not identified in CERS or conveyed earlier in the evaluation process. Some examples are:

- > Remote sites affects the inspections numbers.
- > Ag exemptions affects ER/TP numbers.
- Under-threshold sites affects the CUPA's total HMBP facility numbers, and everything else is based on this number.
 - Note: Some CUPA's enter an identification code in CERS to identify these sites. Communicate this to the evaluators.

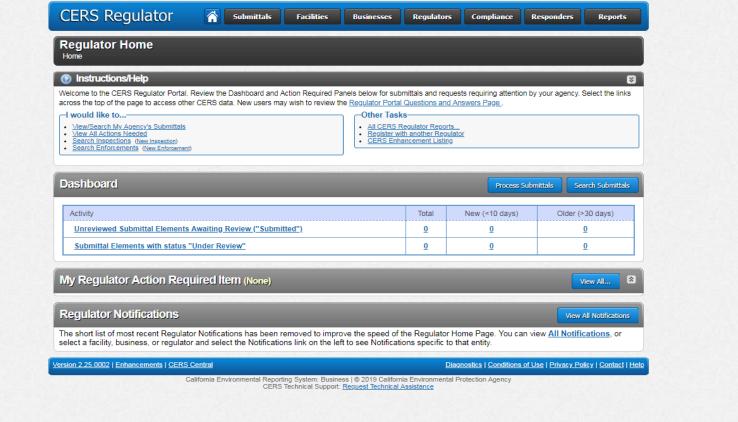


CERS: REGULATOR PORTAL/SIGN IN



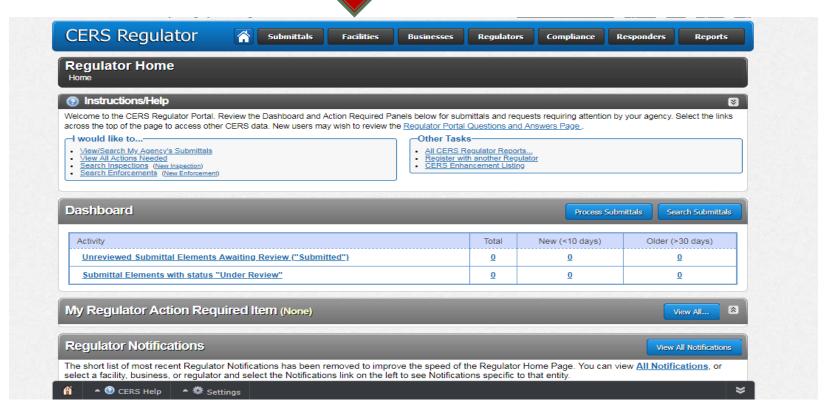


REGULATORS HOME PAGE IN CERS





Evaluation – CERS QUERY

HMBP

We check with the CUPA on:

- Agricultural sites (changes ER/TP)
- Any "deadwood" type facilities
- Remote (changes inspection numbers)
- Under threshold facilities (changes total numbers of HMBP)
- CalARP facilities (changes everything- CERS queries the handler input, not the CUPA's)
- Other databases being use for HMBP inspection documentation.

CalARP

There is not much in CERS for CalARP. Only Inspection dates and whether or not the facility is under CalARP.



CALARP

So, during remote evaluations, we ask the CUPA for a spreadsheet with the following CalARP related items on it.

CalARP

- > The CalARP inspection dates are included in the CERS spreadsheet already generated.
- > Get RMP dates from CUPA from spreadsheet.
- Check for annual performance audits, usually included in the self-audits.
- If CalARP dispute resolution procedure was a deficiency last time, ask for it. There is no deadline date for the Dispute resolution; therefore, they do not go out of date. Can be included in the I&E Plan.
