



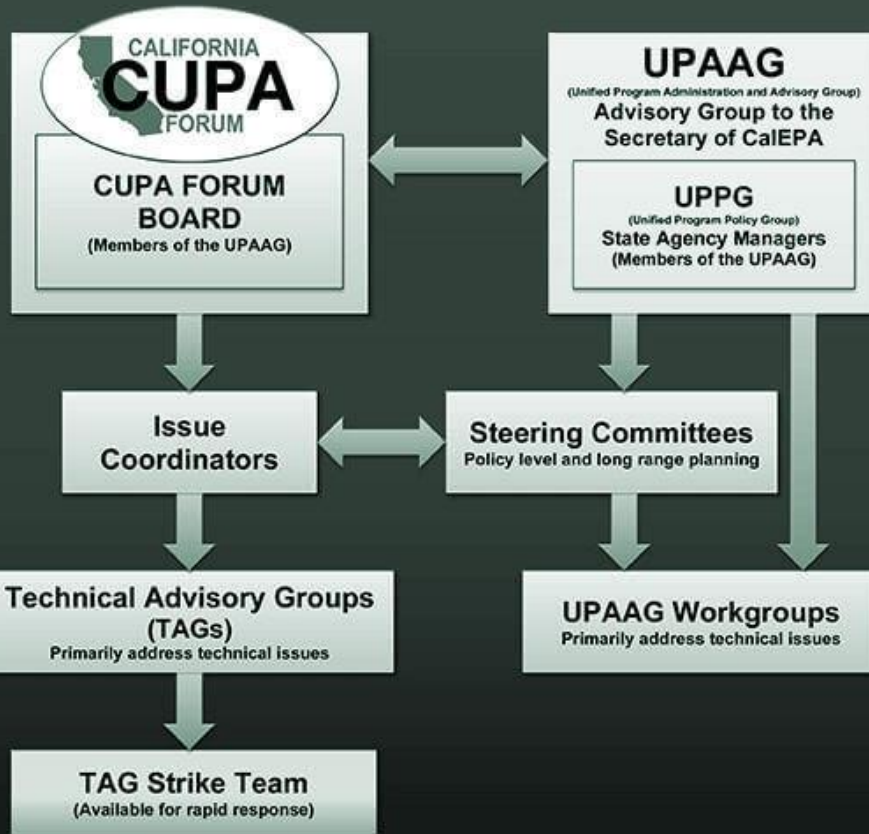

DTSC Overview

➤ Mission Statement:

"The mission of DTSC is to protect California's people and environment from harmful effects of toxic substances by restoring contaminated resources, enforcing hazardous waste laws, reducing hazardous waste generation, and encouraging the manufacture of chemically safer products."

DTSC Statewide Policy Oversight

- Tracking legislation related to HW management
 - Timeframe: 1 – 2 years
- Developing rulemaking packages
 - Timeframe: 2 – 5 years
- Aligning with RCRA
 - Timeframe: 1 – 3 years

HWSC Charter

- Finalized in 2020
- Purpose & Background
- Priorities
- Commitments

- Airbag and seatbelt pre-tensioner guidance
