



> 8+ tips to help keep you sane and achieve compliance perfection

Tip 1: Know Your Operations

- Be walking around
- Be aware of...
 - Inputs and outputs
 - Changes
- Be involved








Tip 2: Match It Up

- Consistency = Credibility
- Numbers need to match
 - ….or know why they don't
 - > Air/water/waste/hazmat
 - Ex. DTSC generator reports/TRI/CDTFA
- > Ensure policies/plans consistent
 - Management of change!





Tip 3: Know ALL The Requirements

State AND Federal

- > CUPA (incl. local requirements)
- Cal EPA and Fed EPA
- Haz Mat (DOT, OSHA, Fire)
- Ex: CalARP/ RMP/ PSM

FORNIA

- Regulations AND Codes
 - > Ex: Excluded Recyclable Material



Tip 4: Get Out Of Your Bubble

- > Relationships Matter
- Internal
 - Learn their needs and systems
- External
 - Learn from others' experience

Tip 5: Embrace Recordkeeping

- Fancy isn't better if it's not used
- > Cloud or traditional file systems
 - Sort by topic/agency/subtopic/year
- Consider Google Forms or similar
- > Electronic monitoring handy
 - But not foolproof
- > Use your eyes!
 - Xeroxed forms, numbers that don't make sense





Tip 6: Integrate


- Environmental Compliance is not a silo
- Environmental Compliance is not your job alone
- Integrate with other work

Tip 7: Check. And Plan and Do.

- > The best laid plans
-get put on a shelf and ignored.
- > Remember... integration!
 - Make compliance easy
- Staff turnover = dropped balls
- Report results or lack thereof





Tip 8: Find A Champion or Two

- Management needs to care
 - > Operational consequences
- > Provide updates
 - > Dashboard, calendars, etc.
- > Don't conceal troubles
 - > Explain, ask for help
