


Paint Stewardship Legislation

- Develop, fund, and operate comprehensive paint management program
 - Reduce, reuse, and recycle paint in an environmentally responsible manner
 - Provide convenient recycling opportunities
 - Conduct public outreach and education
 - Develop a program plan to be approved by the state oversight agency
 - Provide annual report with independent financial audit

American Coatings Association & PaintCare


- American Coatings Association (ACA)
- Member organization that advocates on behalf of manufacturers of paint and coatings for architectural, industrial maintenance, original equipment manufacturer, and specialty coatings and raw material suppliers. Membership is voluntary.

PaintCare

• A subsidiary of ACA, PaintCare is a stewardship organization that designs and operates the paint manufacturer-led recycling programs in states that pass paint stewardship laws.




How is PaintCare Funded





Fee Schedules





Small containers e.g., pints & quarts

\$0.65-\$0.99



Mid-sized containers e.g.,1-2 gallons

\$1.50-\$1.99



Larger sizes up to 5 gallons



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Role of Manufacturer and Retailer



Role of Manufacturers

- Register company and architectural products with PaintCare
- Inform their dealers about the program
- Add PaintCare Fee to wholesale price of program products
- Report sales of program products to PaintCare monthly
- Submit PaintCare Fees to PaintCare monthly



Role of Retailers

- Sell registered brands
- Pass fee through to the consumers on the program products
- Provide customers with program information
- Be a paint collection site (voluntary)



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PaintCare Products

- Interior and exterior architectural paints: latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, oil-based, enamel (including textured coatings)
- Deck Coatings, floor paints (including elastomeric)
- Primers, sealers, undercoaters
- Stains
- Shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethanes (single component)
- Waterproofing concrete/masonry/wood sealers and repellants (not tar or bitumen-based)
- Metal Coatings, rust preventatives
- Field and lawn paints





Non-PaintCare Products

- Paint thinners, mineral spirits,
 solvents
- Aerosol coatings
- Auto and marine paints
- Art and craft paints
- Caulking compounds, epoxies, glues, adhesives
- Paint additives, colorants, tints, resins
- Wood preservatives (containing pesticides)

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Convenience Criteria in California

- Provide 95% of California's population within dropoff site within 15 miles.
- Provide one drop-off site for every 50,000 people.





Sites and Services



Laws Allowing Participation in Our Program

- HSC 25217
 - Conditions for a site to accept paint.
- AB 2748
 - Repeals the requirement for drop-off locations to develop in HMBPs in order to accept paint from the public that is intended to be recycled.

Oil-Based PaintCare Products

- About 25 gallons per month
- Must sign Paint Drop-Off Log



Retail Drop-off Sites

- 562 Retail Sites.
- PaintCare supplies paint collection bins, spill kits, training materials, transportation of paint from the site, and processing.
- New sites receive a training binder and training conducted by a PaintCare Coordinator.



Retail Continued

- PaintCare Coordinators conduct site visits to retail sites every six months.
- Retail sites are provided fiber bins or reusable bins.
- Sites can order a pickup on demand or be place on an automatic pickup schedule.







HHW, Solid Waste Facilities & Other Sites

- 189 Sites.
- PaintCare supplies paint collection bins, spill kits, training materials, transportation of paint from the site, and processing.
- Coordinators can conduct an initial onboarding training, and annual site visits.



Large Volume Pickup Service

- Available to residents and businesses that have 100 gallons or more.
- Customer can submit a request at paintcare.org.



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Reoccurring Large Volume User

- 69 RLVP sites.
- Service provided to organizations that generate large volumes of paint on a regular basis.
- PaintCare supplies paint collection bins, spill kits, training materials, transportation of paint from the site, and processing.
- Coordinators conduct an initial onboarding training, and annual site visits.

PaintCare Events

- Held 8 PaintCare events in FY23.
- PaintCare offers one-day dropoff events in areas where dropoff sites aren't as conveniently located or where there is a higher demand for paint recycling.




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Reuse Focused Events

- Multi year pilot began in 2022 to explore the feasibility of offering reuse focused events and increase reuse across California.
- Hosted 7 events, gave away
 16,237 gallons of paint.








Reuse Focused Events





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Map of Sites









These products have a fee when you buy them and are accepted for drop-off at no

- Interior and exterior architectural paints: latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd,
- oil-based, enamel (including textured coatings) Deck coatings, floor paints (including elastometic)
- Primers, sealers, undercoaters
- Shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethones (single component)
- Waterproofing concrete/masonry/wood sealers and repellents. Inot far or hitsman-based)
- Metal coulings, rust preventatives
- Field and lown paints

Products must be in original containers with original labels. Latex paint that is dried out and "rook hard" is also acceptable.

Non-PaintCare Products

These products do not have a fee when purchased and are not accepted at

- Paint thinners, mineral spirits, solvents
- Agrosol paints (spray cans)
- Auto and marine paints Arts and crafts paints
- Caulic epoxies, glues, achesives


