Mission

Promote and unite the steel plate fabricated products industry through **standards** development, **education**, and **communication**.



SP001 Standard for the Inspection of Aboveground Storage Tanks

Provides inspection and evaluation criteria required to determine the suitability for continued service of aboveground storage tanks until the next scheduled inspection.



History and Evolution of SP001

- STI encouraged by regulators to create a standard for shop fabricated tanks
- Standard initially created by STI members and staff
- First edition released in 2000
- Quickly adopted by some regulators



History and Evolution of SP001

- Revised in 2004
- New version created by group of fifteen stake holders to address consensus concerns
- Reviewed every five years
- 7th edition released in 2024



SP031 Standard for Repair of Shop-Fabricated Aboveground Storage Tanks

Covers repair and modification of shop-fabricated steel tanks storing stable, flammable and combustible liquids with a specific gravity not greater than 1.0, operating at atmospheric pressure and temperatures between ambient temperature and 200°F.



SP031 Standard for Repair of Shop-Fabricated Aboveground Tanks

- First edition released in 2003
- Reviewed every five years
- 6th edition released in 2024



SP001/SP031 Standards Committee

- Committee formed in August 2022:
 - 8 Shop Fabricated Tank Manufacturers
 - 8 Regulators
 - 6 Owners
 - 6 Consultants
 - 2 Component Manufacturers



SP001/SP031 Standards Committee

- Public comments were accepted until October 21, 2022
- SP001: 52 comments received
- SP031: 16 comments received
- Held several meetings to review comments and determine whether technical or editorial changes were needed
- Subcommittees formed for items that needed additional discussion



SP001/SP031 Standards Committee

- Drafts created for committee to review
- Ballot process opened for committee
- Any negative comments were reviewed and addressed
- Final ballot issued
- Standards published February 2024
