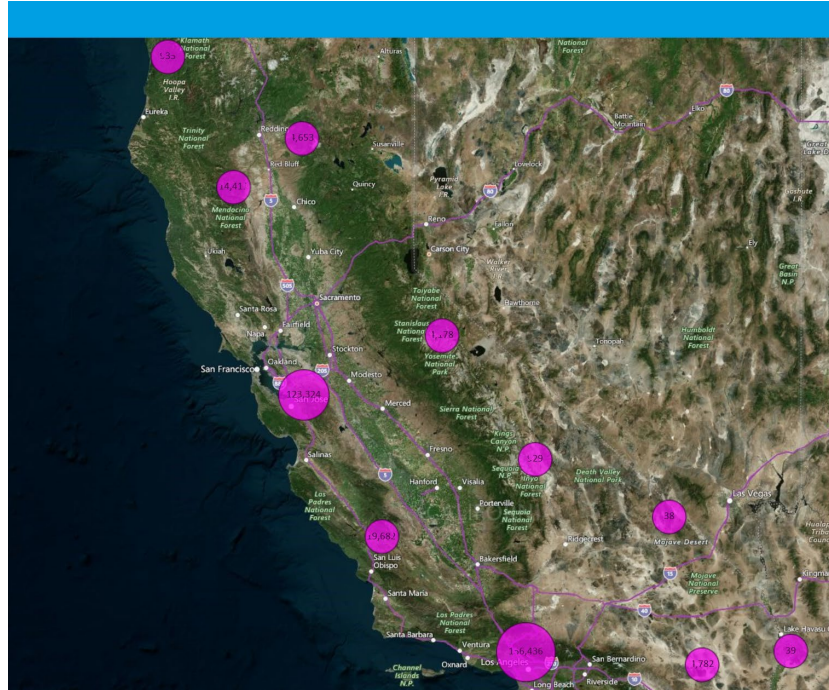


Regulated Site Portal

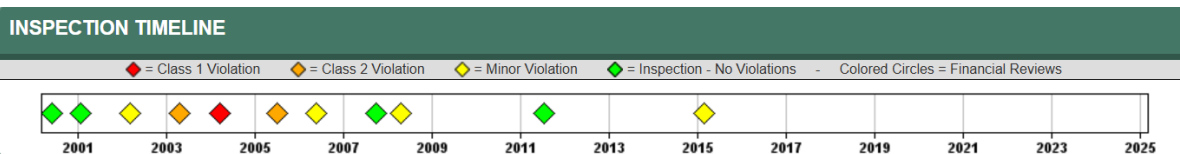
The most recent permit modification is a Class 1 modification effective September 5, 2023 to replace the fume hood equipment in three of the units (a phase for each unit over the course of three years).

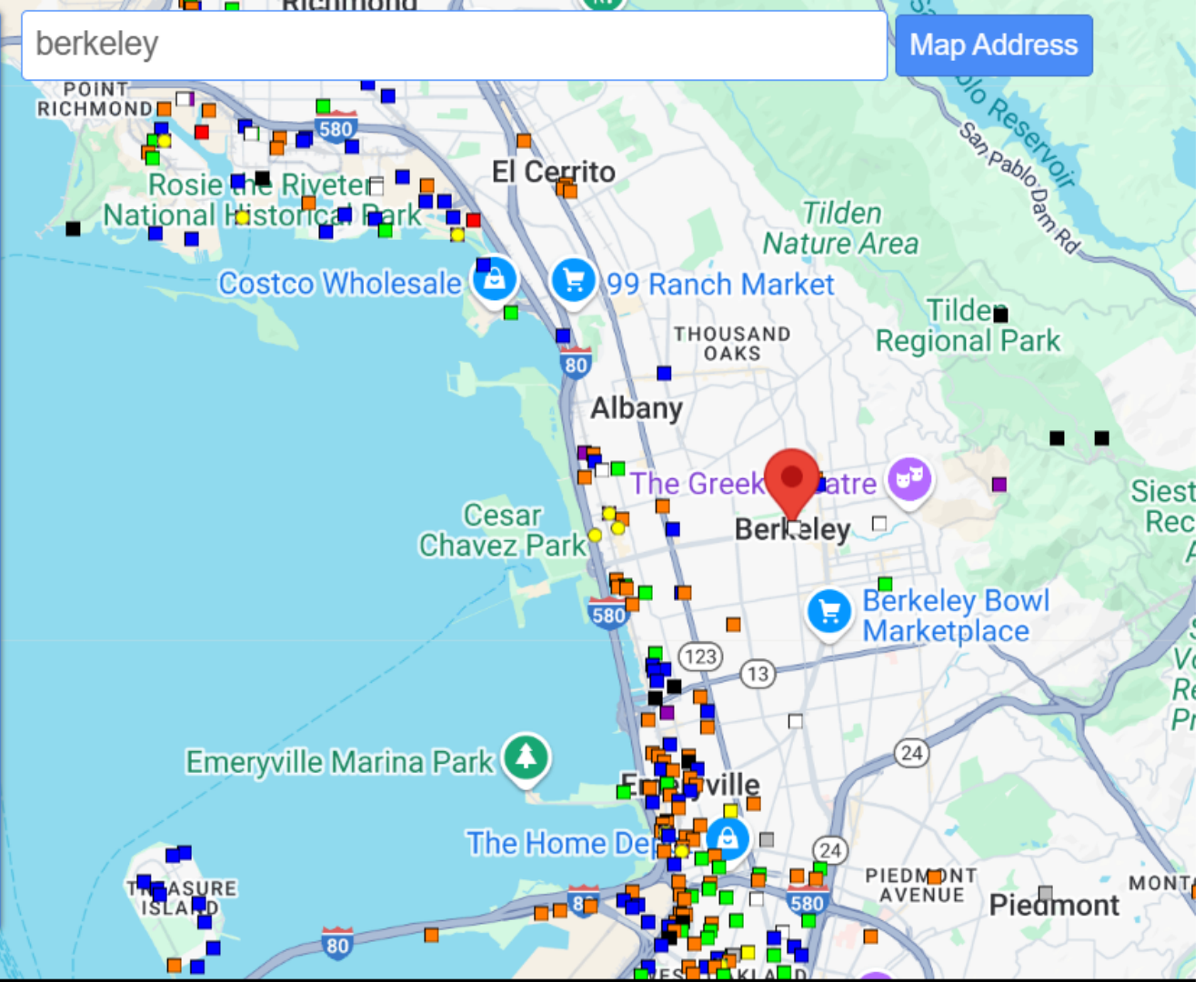

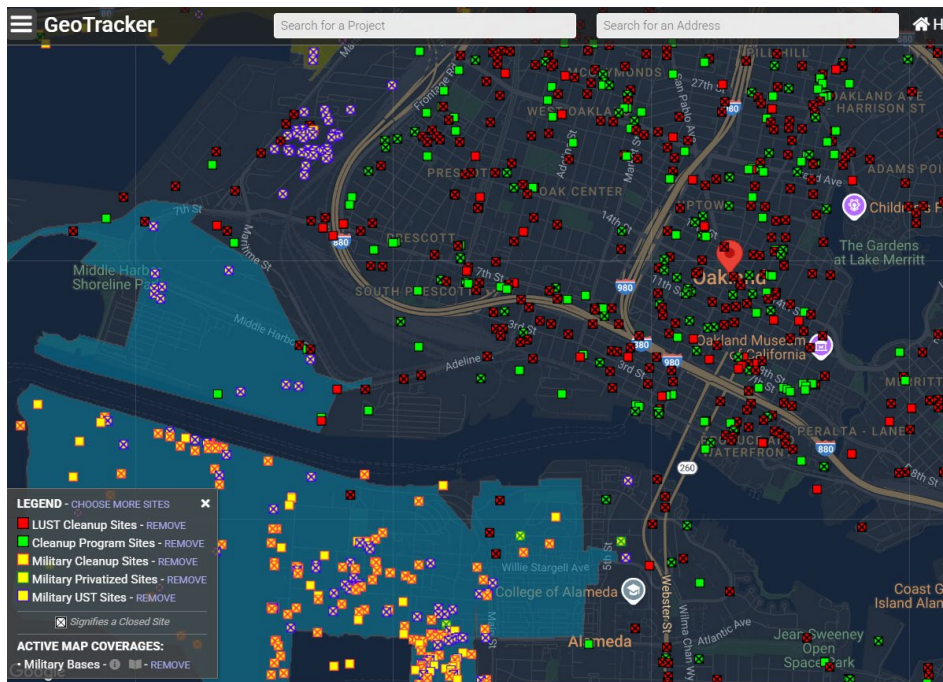
GeoTracker

Users can view data on Geotracker through a Google Maps GIS interface.

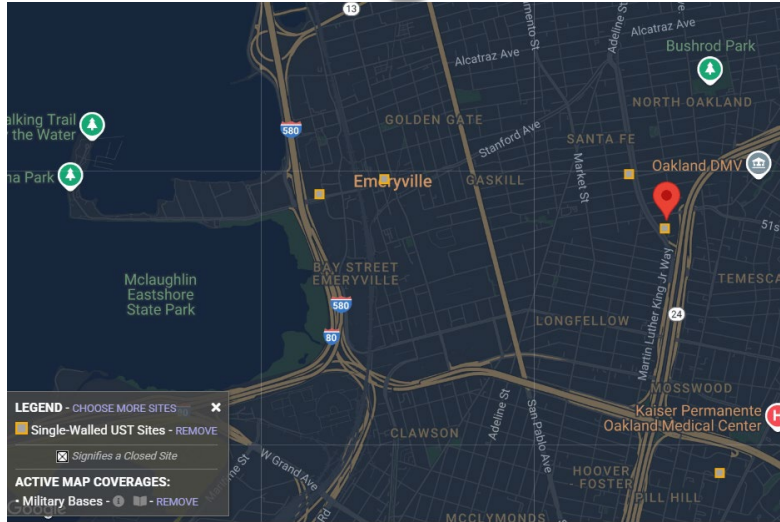

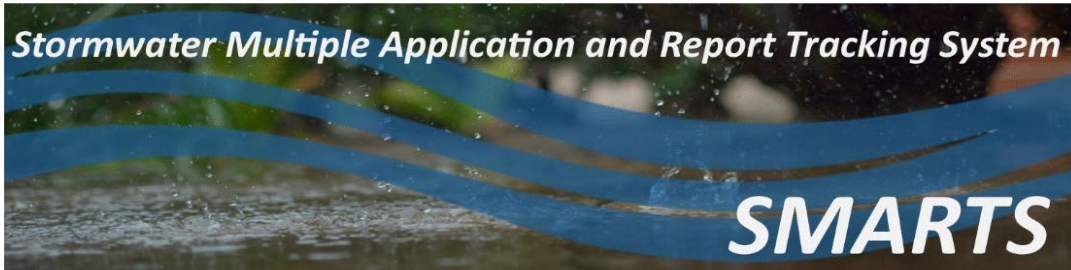

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SMARTS

Purpose: SMARTS is the SWRCB's platform where dischargers, regulators, and the public can enter, manage and view stormwater data including permit registration documents, compliance and monitoring data associated with California's Storm Water General Permits.

But first, what is stormwater?



Defined by US EPA as runoff generated when precipitation flows over land and impervious surfaces without percolating into the ground. Stormwater mobilizes pollutants such as motor oil and trash, and in most cases flows directly to bodies of water. The Federal Clean Water Act prohibits certain discharges of stormwater containing pollutants except in compliance with a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

Stormwater General Permits

The NPDES stormwater program regulates stormwater discharges from three potential sources: municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s), construction activities, and industrial activities.

Attachment A of the Industrial General Permit defines the types of facilities required to have a permit:

1. Facilities subject to stormwater effluent limitations guidelines
2. Manufacturing Facilities
3. Oil and Gas/Mining Facilities
4. Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage or Disposal Facilities
5. Landfills, Land Application Sites, and Open Dumps
6. Recycling Facilities
7. Steam Electric Power Generating Facilities
8. Transportation Facilities
9. Sewage or Wastewater Treatment Works
